G2 Net-Zero LNG LLC ("G2 LNG") submits this request to vacate its LNG export authorization to free trade agreement ("FTA") countries granted under Docket No. 15-44-LNG/Order No. 3682 and withdraw its pending application for LNG export authorization to non-free trade agreement ("NFTA") countries pending under Docket No. 15-45-LNG.

Since submitting its applications for LNG export authorization, G2 LNG's corporate focus has shifted away from LNG export activities to development of net-zero greenhouse gas emission energy products. Thus, G2 LNG recently decided to cease development of its previously planned natural gas liquefaction facilities in Cameron Parish, Louisiana.
